Description

This project will include the installation of riprap slopes to maintain the future integrity of the banks and the back yards of the homeowners.

Justification

Residences built along Apple Creek Circle and Cherry Creek Circle back up to Apple Creek. The channel has adequate capacity for the transmission of runoff. However, the banks of Apple Creek are too steep and have experienced erosion. The City of Bryan has received repeated requests to repair the banks to Apple Creek by local residents. This has become an annual maintenance problem that is addressed by the City staff. The access for maintenance is marginal at best. This project may require the City to acquire additional drainage easements and/or temporary easements for construction.
