Justification

Currently there is a single entrance and exit from the Copperfield subdivision. The number of homes and the number of vehicles traveling through the neighborhood daily has created a need for a second entrance/exit. From the Copperfield Subdivision, extending Canterbury Dr. to intersect FM 158 at University would relieve the congestion in this community, at Sam Houston Elementary and improve traffic flow at the Copperfield Dr./Booneville Rd intersection.
