

Summer Parks Program

Rules and Standards

General Rules:

1. Everyone must wear **closed toed shoes** at all times!
2. If children are sick, infected with pinkeye, lice, or any other communicable disease, please do not send them to the program. This is to protect your child and the health of the other staff and participants. Before your child is permitted back to the program, treatment must be provided and verified by staff in order to ensure the disease is no longer contagious.
3. Fighting, abusive language, and excessive disruptive behavior will result in immediate removal of the program. Please encourage your children to follow the directions of the Camp Counselors. Parents may be contacted to pick up their children if this behavior consistently occurs.
4. When the children come each day they are to stay until the very end of the program. ***They are not allowed to leave the program unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.***
5. A child may be dropped off no earlier than **12:00PM** and can be picked up no later than **5:00PM**.
6. The **Registration Form** must be signed by parent/legal guardian at registration or they will not be allowed to attend the program.
7. If bad weather occurs before the program starts each day the program will be cancelled. Should this happen, staff will be at the park to notify participants and answer any further questions.
8. If bad weather occurs during the program the parents are expected to pick up their child/children. Parents will also be contacted by staff. If you're not sure about the weather then please call **209-5528**.
9. Water will be provided throughout the day.
10. Children are encouraged NOT to bring their own equipment (i.e. bicycles, basketballs, etc.) to the program. City of Bryan is not responsible for any items lost or stolen.

Field Trips and Swimming Rules:

1. Swimsuits **MUST** be worn on swim days. Children not wearing swimsuits will not be allowed to swim. Male swimsuits must have inner liners.
2. Swim tests will be performed each time we go swimming to ensure the ability and safety of your child and the other participants.
3. While on field trips children must remain seated on the bus at all times until instructed to depart from the bus.
4. The **Field Trip Release Form** must be signed by a parent/legal guardian in order for children to participate in the field trips.
