07/14/15:

Officer Tollison and I responded to a call at [REDACTED] and met with the RP, [REDACTED]. She advised that there was a dog in a crate in a neighbors back yard. We went with [REDACTED] into her backyard and observed the dog through the fence. The dog was in a wire crate and was active and alert. After leaving [REDACTED] home, we went to the dog owner's home at [REDACTED]. There was no one home when we arrived. There was a small terrier mix tied out to a tree in the front yard and we were also able to see the dog in the crate from the right side of the yard. The dog in the crate was still active and alert and was standing up. We were able to see that it was a medium size lab mix, chocolate in color. We walked up the driveway on the right side of the yard and could not see into the crate due to stuff leaning against it but the dog was sitting up and we could see its head. The dog was inside a fenced in area under in a shady area. We did not go into the backyard due to it being fenced. We left a warning on the front door for the owners to contact ACO within 48 hours.

07/15/15:

Officer Tollison and I still had not received a call from the owner so we went by to do a follow up around 10 am. When we arrived no one was home and we found the warning by the trash can and we placed it back on the front door. We could not see the dog in the crate in the backyard from either side of the yard. We walked up the driveway and we could see the create but did not see the dog due to stuff leaning up against the crate. We whistled and made noise and still did not see the dog. We assumed the dog was not in the crate.

Officer Tollison received a call on his work cell phone around 1125 hrs from the original RP, [REDACTED] and she advised that the dog was dead in the crate in the backyard. This call came in after we had done our follow up that morning. I spoke to her on the phone. She is very upset that we did not take the dog yesterday. I tried to explain that the dog was alert and active yesterday at the time of the call and we cannot remove a dog without court paperwork (seizure warrant).

I called [REDACTED] dog owner, and left her a message advising to call ASAP as we received a call her dog was deceased. About that time, I also found a phone number for [REDACTED]. I was able to speak with him and advised him that his dog was deceased. He advised that his dog was alive that morning when he left for work and that the evening before the dog had been dry heaving. He also stated that the dog was not active like she normal is when he went to work that morning. I also advised him that we had left a warning on his door on 07/14/15 asking for contact about the dog being outside in the backyard. He stated that they did not have a warning on the door when he arrived home from work. I explained that we found the warning laying in the driveway next to the trash can and we had placed it back on the door.

After speaking with [REDACTED] I updated my supervisor about the situation. She asked that I contact [REDACTED] and see if he would allow us to pick up the dog and take it to Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory for a necropsy. [REDACTED] was very cooperative and gave us permission to remove the dog for the necropsy. When we arrived on scene, between 1200 hrs and 1230 hrs, the neighbor from [REDACTED] came outside to speak to us. I informed her that we had permission from [REDACTED] to go into the yard and remove the dog. She told us that the RP, [REDACTED] had been over to the house earlier and had gone into the backyard. I asked the neighbor from [REDACTED] to call for patrol if she sees anyone go into the yard. When we got into the backyard we found the dog deceased in her crate. There was a red 5 gallon bucket that had been knocked over. We noticed that the dog had a prolapsed rectum when removed it from the crate. After loading the dog we went to the Bryan Animal Center and met with our supervisor. She also looked at the dog and noticed the prolapsed rectum and noticed that the dog was in good body condition. We placed the dog into the fridge and contacted Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory and made arrangements for the necropsy. Officer Molina transported the dog to the lab. I called [REDACTED] after the dog left for the lab to let him know it was being sent and that we would notify him when we received the results.

07/21/15:

[REDACTED] Dog owner: I met with [REDACTED] at his house and the small dog is now a house dog and is doing great. The dog has a vet appointment but he did not know the date but said he would find out from his wife. Also, the dog had a rabies tag on as well. His name is [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was very cooperative and answered all my questions. He said they did not know that their home address was posted on social media until a family friend told them about it after watching the news. And because of this they have started

to receive hate mail. I advised them to keep the letters. He said that they are and they have already spoken with PD about it and have consulted with a lawyer. While speaking to him he said that his neighbor called him to let him know that the dog had gotten loose on Tuesday morning. The neighbor put the dog up and made sure it had water. He also stated that their neighbor comes over and checks on the dogs since they have to work and has topped off the water bucket. I told him to contact me if he has any questions or concerns and to call PD if they need them. I also told him I would contact him when we got the report on the Necropsy.

I later received word that the initial report had been received and called [REDACTED] to let him know. I advised him that we would not be making that information public until we spoke with a professional who would be able to decipher its information. Both the Pathologist, who performed the necropsy and a State Regional Veterinarian were consulted.

07/22/15:

[REDACTED] (neighbor to the left when facing the house:) I met with the neighbor and he advised that they have looked after [REDACTED] dog for them when they were at work and have from time to time put the dog up when she escaped and would make sure that the dog had water. He also advised that the RP, [REDACTED] had been over and asked her to leave (not sure on that date). He said that the owners have always taken care of the dogs and that they all look out for each other. While I was there [REDACTED] came outside with [REDACTED] and she informed me that he is a Husky/Rat Terrier mix, according to the person they got him from. This is the first time I was able to speak with her. She advised that he has a vet appointment on Friday this week. She also told me about the hate mail. I told her the same thing I told her husband. I also advised her to call PD if they needed anything.

[REDACTED] (neighbor to the right when facing the house:) I met with the neighbor and she advised me that Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED] have always helped her out and have cared for her dog when she was out of town or in the hospital. She also stated the RP [REDACTED] had come over one day to complain about the dog barking. She asked her to leave her property at that time and stated that she has not had an issue with the dog barking. She said that the [REDACTED] are good neighbors and good dog owners and have never seen them mistreat their dogs.

Both neighbors at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] said that they would be willing to testify on the [REDACTED] behalf if need be. I thanked both for their time and help. I spoke to both neighbors individually.

Also, while I was out at the house on 07/14/15 the neighbor from [REDACTED] came outside to speak with us. At that time she advised that she has put up the dog before when it got out and would also give it water during the day when the [REDACTED] were at work. She was not at home when I met with her husband on 07/22/15.

As I stated earlier in the report on 07/15/15 when Officer Tollison and I arrived at [REDACTED] we found the warning that we had left the previous day in the driveway next to the trash can. At that time we picked up the warning and placed it back on the door and we were not sure how it had gotten there. When I spoke to Mr. [REDACTED] on 07/15/15 he stated that they did not have a warning on their door when they got home from work that evening. It was later when I spoke to the neighbor at [REDACTED] on 07/22/15; that I was told the RP, Ms [REDACTED] had gone back to the house after we left on 07/14/15 and walked up to the door. The neighbor stated that she was reading the warning that we left on the door for the dog owners.

On 07/23/15 Officer Cox and I met with Assistant County Attorney Brenda Bailey. I presented her with the facts from the case, including the necropsy report. After reviewing the facts of the case she advised that there is insufficient evidence to pursue animal cruelty charges at this time.

I have attached a copy of the necropsy to the report.
