Description

This project would construct a 12' shared use path along the north side of E 29th Street from the College Station city limit to Carter Creek Parkway, including a pedestrian bridge. It would update curb ramps to ADA compliance at the intersections of E 29th Street with Sandia Plaza, Carter Creek Parkway, Briar Oaks Drive, Wilde Oak Circle, Greenfield Plaza, and Barak Lane. It would also construct short connections of 6' sidewalk for Carter Creek Parkway and Briar Oaks Drive.

Justification

E 29th Street from the city limit to Carter Creek Parkway is shown on both the Bicycle and Sidewalk Master Plans. A shared use path would connect a proposed bike route along Carter Creek Parkway to proposed and existing bike routes on Autumn Circle and Spring Loop in College Station. Citizens have requested sidewalks along this route, which is already used by pedestrians as a dirt footpath. Short 6' sidewalk extensions for Carter Creek Parkway and Briar Oaks Drive would improve the sidewalk network. Updating intersection curb ramps for ADA compliance would improve safety and comply with the ADA Transition Plan.
