Description

Construct 5 foot wide sidewalks both sides on East 30th Street from S. Ennis St. to Walker St. This would include ADA compliant ramps and driveway crossing to tie in to the sidewalks that end at S. Ennis St. on the North side.

Justification

There have been several reported near misses between pedestrians and vehicular traffic on E 30th Street where the sidewalks end at S Ennis St. This is a foot traffic route to the Steven F. Austin Middle School, St. Joseph School, and Fannin Elementary School from the nearby residential community. This project would reduce these conflicts take better advantage of existing sidewalks and improve pedestrian safety in this area especially for students.
