## Description

W Villa Maria Road from FM 2818 to SH 47

This project will construct a shared use path along the north side of W Villa Maria Road (FM 1179) with lighting. This shared use path was shown on the Hike & Bike Plan for the 2016 Comprehensive Plan update. This facility will provide non-motorized connections between residential neighborhoods and shopping. It will also provide safe pedestrian access to Mary Branch Elementary School, Brazos Christian School, and a future Bryan ISD school on land near the Jones Road intersection. If awarded, this TxDOT-administered grant will provide 80% of construction funding.
