Description

This project will convert Woodville Road from an open ditch roadway to a curb and gutter with storm sewer from Texas Avenue to State Highway 6 (Earl Rudder Freeway). The new roadway width would be a 37 foot wide minor collector with sidewalks on both sides. Right of way will be needed in order to widen the roadway. The road has primarily residential driveways but yet connects two major thoroughfares.

Justification

Woodville is listed on the Thoroughfare plan as a Minor Arterial roadway and it has a grade separation at Earl Rudder Freeway and serves as the primary east west route for the North Bryan area. The roadway really needs sidewalks to improve pedestrian safety.
