Description

There has been talk about a loop around the backside of the Copperfield Subdivision for a number of years. This project would essentially create a close loop around the back of Copperfield and Miramont subdivisions. The project extends University Drive from its intersection with Boonville Road (FM 158) to FM1179 hugging the back side of the Copperfield and Miramont Subdivisions. The roadway section would be a 37 foot wide minor collector roadway and would include storm sewer and sidewalks on both sides. Right of way would have to be acquired for approximately 2/3 of the project, the other 1/3 has already been acquired. Several roadways including Canterbury Drive would need to be extended or connected to this roadway to provide access.

Justification

This roadway extension is shown on the Thoroughfare plan as a Super Arterial and has been talked about and planned for 20 years. This roadway would provide an alternate route for traffic from Copperfield and Miramont subdivisions as well as traffic from the east on FM1179 to have direct access to University Drive and the Texas A&M Campus. This extension would also help spur continued development in the area.
