Description

This section of Villa Maria has seen recent pavement deterioration and sees significant vehicular traffic from Blinn College. The pavement deterioration signifies the need for the road subgrade to be stabilized and reconstructed. This project could be combined with the sidewalk project proposed in the CIP.

Justification

This project was part of the street masterplan prepared by Freese and Nichols. Staff selected this street due to its size and therefore reconstruction cost. It is a 5 lane wide roadway and has a box culvert crossing that has been reported in TXDOT's most recent bridge inspection report as being functionally deficient. It's condition is not an immediate safety concern but one that needs to be addressed when the roadway is reconstructed.
