Widen and reconstruct East 29th through the curve to create super-elevation and accommodate bike lanes and construct 6 foot wide sidewalks on both sides from Carter Creek Pkwy to the city limits near Tarrow Street. The bridge at Burton Creek would need to be reconstructed to accommodate additional width.

Justification

This section of roadway sees guite a number of cyclist and pedestrian traffic, but the curved road section and narrow street width increase the danger to cyclist. Additionally the curved section is crowned and should be banked or superelevated to enhance safe maneuvering by motorist. This project would also include 6 ft. sidewalks on both side to provide safe pedestrian paths along this busy corridor. This would significantly enhance the safety of the section of East 29th street and provide multi-modal transportation opportunities to the citizens in this area. This project has been submitted as a MPO/MTP project, which also includes widening Tarrow Street for bike lanes and installation of sidewalks from the City limits on East 29th Street to University Drive.
