Description

This project will replace existing storms sewer along the drainage easement beginning at 2205 Wayside Drive to the outfall at Burton Creek in two location: between Esther and Ethel and at the cul-de-sac. Additional sewer would be added to intercept surface flow at the intersection of Ethel and Wayside and connect to the existing storm sewer system.

Justification

The current stormdrain system is undersized to convey the large amount of flow generated by the Townshire Shopping Center. Excess flows travel through private property on the way to the creek. Numerous complaints have been received by property owners along the alignment of the stormdrain system. Flood insurance claims have been filed by property owners that have been affected.
