



## PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CITY OF BRYAN

### ANIMAL ORDINANCE - 10.31.2018 UPDATE



At the Bryan Animal Center Advisory Committee meeting on Thursday, October 18, 2018, feedback from citizens was shared and the committee took into consideration the comments, concerns, and questions posed about the proposed changes to the existing animal ordinance. A number of updates have been made as a result of community input and are summarized below. The Animal Center Advisory Committee will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, November 15, 2018, at 5:30 PM in Council Chambers of the Municipal Office Building and these proposed changes will be an item for discussion.

- Updated definitions of Community Cats and Trap-neuter-return to allow for microchipping and/or ear-tipping.
- Added Mini-pig definition.
- **Sec. 10-110 - Animals in trucks and trailers:** Added requirement for flooring between animal and truck bed if temperature is above 85 degrees.
- **Sec. 10-33 Keeping Livestock:**
  - updated wording, (a) It is a violation to maintain livestock on properties other than those zoned for such use, except if the maintenance of livestock is a legal non-conforming use.
  - (f) added exception for mini-pigs provided that requirements are met.
  - (h) added that this is only applicable within City limits.
- **Sec. 10-135 Rabbits,** removed time limited restriction for Agricultural Youth Projects.
- **Sec. 10-137 Beekeeping,** updated wording on (b) to allow for water source to be on same property within line of sight of a hive.
