Each pedicab vehicle must be equipped with the following:

1. A headlight capable of emitting a light at a distance of 500 feet or greater, as delegated by the Texas Transportation Code Sec. 551.104;
2. Two (2) properly functioning and operating taillights;
3. Properly functioning and operating turn signals;
4. Rear and side reflective devices;
5. A properly functioning and operating braking system;
6. A properly functioning and operating horn;
7. A rearview mirror;
8. Sufficient rubber and treading on all wheels;
9. A slow moving vehicle emblem;
10. Seatbelts installed by the Pedicab manufacturer; and
11. A sign on the body of the pedicab stating the name under which the pedicab is operated. The name must be in letters not less than two and one-half (2 ½) in height and five-sixteenths (5/16) of an inch in width, and must be a solid color that contrasts with the background.
