## Emergency Assistance Working Capital Special Economic Development Grant

Bryan for-profit small businesses located in Bryan, TX that are affected by closures or interruptions due to the COVID-19 pandemic may be eligible for federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) working capital funds from \$10,000 to \$30,000 to create and/or retain jobs for low- to moderate-income employees.

Number of Employees	Maximum Grant Amount
1 – 5	\$10,000
6 – 10	\$20,000
11 +	\$30,000

### Allowable Grant Usage:

- Pay Fixed Debts
- Payroll
- Accounts Payable
- Bills to Operate business

\*May not be used to pay delinquent property taxes, any late fees, or delinquent amounts owed to BTU.

- 2.) At least 51% of employees are low and moderate income and/or Business is located within a census block group that has a poverty rate of at least 20%.
- 3.) One-Year Contract Required
