REQUIRED HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY
CITY OF BRYAN MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER

**FACE COVERINGS
ARE REQUIRED TO
ENTER & REMAIN
ON PREMISES.**

PURSUANT TO THE MAYOR'S EMERGENCY ORDER ISSUED
JUNE 26, 2020 AND TAKING EFFECT ON JUNE 30, 2020:

All occupants above the age of 10 must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth, such as a homemade mask, scarf, bandana, or handkerchief. Occupants include employees, customers, visitors, invitees and contractors. Face coverings are required when in an area or performing an activity that necessarily involves close contact or proximity to others and where 6 feet of separation is not feasible.

The virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread by infected people who have few or no symptoms. To reduce the public health threat and to protect our employees and community, this business has adopted and implemented, at a minimum, the face covering requirement as part of its required health and safety policy under the emergency order.
