

Sensitive Receptors Approval Form

Required for Burn Permit Authorization Near Adjacent Structures

In accordance with Texas Administrative Code 30 TAC Chapter 111, Subchapter B and 2021 International Fire Code, outdoor burning must be conducted downwind of or at least 300 feet from any structure containing sensitive receptors located on adjacent properties, unless prior written approval is obtained from the adjacent occupant with possessory control.

This form must be completed and submitted as part of the burn permit application if burning is planned within 300 feet of an adjacent occupied structure.
