REPORT OF HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX

Per City Ordinance No. 1742, "each calendar month is a reporting period and the taxes imposed by and collected under this Article are due and payable to the chief financial officer on or before the 20th day of the month following the end of each calendar month. If a taxpayer owes less than \$500 for a calendar month or \$1,500 for a calendar quarter, the taxpayer qualifies as a quarterly filer having a reporting period of a calendar quarter and the taxes are due and payable on the 20th day after the end of the calendar quarter.
