DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

M. Darrell Lovelette, Director of Parks & Recreation

This year is stacking up to be the most exciting one to occur in a number of years within the Parks and Recreation Department. We have and are embarking on a number of park projects and introducing some new programs throughout the year. The next 12 months promise to be exciting and will offer everyone an opportunity to enjoy new facilities, improved facilities and a number of new programs.

In an effort to keep everyone informed, a summary of the major park, facilities and program changes that will be taking place follows:

SADIE THOMAS PARK SWIMMING POOL – The construction of this new leisure style pool is underway. The pool will consist of a zero entry area with three water features which include bubblers, a Mushroom and an Aquatic Dome. There are also lap lanes, ample deck area, and a new restroom facility. The pool surface is close to 4,000 square feet. The pool will be open Memorial Day weekend.

WILLIAMSON PARK SKATE PARK – Grindline Skate Parks is our design/build contractor for this project. The skate park will consist of a 17,500 square foot facility that will offer challenges to skaters and bikers of all abilities. The work will also include a new restroom facility and improved lighting. This skate park is being constructed in Williamson Park at the site of the old skate park. We anticipate that a Grand Opening for this skate park will occur in mid to late July.



BRYAN AQUATIC CENTER RENOVATIONS – The City hired The C.T. Brannon Corporation to draw up the design and construction specifications for major renovations to this aquatic facility. The renovations will include the replacement of the liner, renovation of the bulkhead, transformation of the recreation side to a leisure style design with zero entry, and upgrades to the filter room, equipment and system. We expect to go out to bid in the spring, award the construction contract in the summer and start work on this facility the first week in September.


PARK SYSTEM RENOVATIONS – In the FY16 budget funding was set aside to start addressing a multitude of operation and maintenance needs throughout the park system. These needs were prioritized and are being addressed per the priority lists. Over this year residents should see a number of renovations in the park which could include new benches, tables, grills, bleachers and water fountains; renovated turf; renovated or replaced fitness stations; renovated landscaping; better lighting; a number of areas cleaned and repainted; repairs to trails; and repairs to other equipment and amenities. Some of these renovations and repairs have already been completed.

PARKS MASTER PLAN – In July, 2015, Freese Nichols was hired to help the City of Bryan update and develop a new Comprehensive Plan and Parks Master Plan for the City of Bryan. On Wednesday, August 26, 2015 the process started with a tour of the city and a series of meetings. The Parks Master Plan was last approved in 2002 so is long overdue to be updated. Dunkin Sims Stoffels Inc. is the firm hired by Freese Nichols to be responsible for the development of the Parks Master Plan. A series of public meetings have been and will continue to be held concerning both the Parks Master Plan and the City Comprehensive Plan over the next few months. Please check the web site and newspaper for updates especially concerning public meetings. It is important for the public to be involved and give us input. The plan is scheduled to be finalized in late summer.

BRYAN CITY CEMETERY EXPANSION – Construction for the expansion of the Bryan City Cemetery is underway with the hiring of the contractor for this expansion. Ground will be broken for the project the first week in February. The expansion will provide over 800 lots with 12 spaces per lot which will address the need for years to come. It is anticipated that the expansion will be completed by July 1, 2016.

RECREATION DIVISION PROGRAMS – Last year and again this year this division has, and will be, adding new programs and redefining some old ones to better meet the needs of our residents. This past year we had record numbers in quite a few programs and are looking to build on this success. Examples of some of our latest or upcoming programs are Dog Obedience classes, Youth Karate, SCUBA, Confectionary Classes, Japanese – Language and Culture, and a Youth Basketball Clinic.

To stay abreast of the progress of what is listed, we will be sending out updates on our web page, facebook page, and other social media along with monthly reports at the Parks Advisory Board meetings. These meetings are held at the Municipal Office Building the third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 pm. Please try to attend.

Program Registrations and Facility Rentals

Registration for all programs and facility reservations are available by one of the following:

Participants will be required to register their household in order to register for programs or facility reservations.

Transfers & Refunds

If you are not completely satisfied with a class, activity and/or rental, please contact us so we can respond to your concerns. In addition to using your feedback to help us improve, we will arrange one of the following:

For programs - Placement into another class, credit for future enrollment or a refund.

For rentals - Reschedule facility rental or refund. Refunds will only be allowed due to cancellations prior to the rental date. The rental contract must be returned to the Parks and Recreation office at least 1 day prior to the scheduled rental.

All refunds for programs and facility rentals will be assessed a fee of \$10 or 10% of the total fee, whichever is higher.

Returned Check Policy

The City of Bryan will assess a \$15 service charge for all returned checks. Participation in leagues, classes and/or facility rentals will not be allowed until the check and service charges are paid in full.

Program information

Programs and classes will meet at City of Bryan, Bryan Parks and Recreation, BISD and area business facilities. Specific class information will be given to each participant upon registration.

Cancelled Classes

The Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel classes, change times or locations, and to substitute instructors as deemed necessary. Classes will be cancelled 24 hours in advance of the scheduled start date if the minimum enrollment numbers are not met.

Medical Policy

The Parks and Recreation Department will not prohibit any person from participating in an activity due to a medical condition or handicap, unless such condition is likely to cause injury to that individual or to other activity participants.

Liabilities

The City of Bryan cannot be held responsible for any loss, material or otherwise, incurred while following an instructor's directions. The City of Bryan is not responsible for any personal property left at any class site. Students take classes at their own risk.

The student will learn the basic Japanese language structure and communication skills to travel around the country. At each class, both written and conversational Japanese are introduced and practiced. Also at each class, the topic related vocabularies are introduced.

HOW TO PREPARE A "FAMILY STYLE" SUSHI

The instructor will show how to prepare a family-style sushi dish with ingredients which can be found at local grocery stores. We will also discuss types of food available in Japan. The instructor will also explain the table manners for Japanese meals.



The City of Bryan is proud to partner with Aggieland Scuba to offer PADI Open Water Diver Scuba courses. The course will be held in various locations with the pool diving portions of the class at the Bryan Aquatic Center and classroom presentations and exams at Aggieland Scuba.

In this course you will complete 5 knowledge development sections with quizzes and exams, 5 confined water (pool) dives, and 4 open water dives held at various locations around our area. The open water dives will be held on a separate weekend from the classroom & pool portions of the course and will be scheduled with the instructor during your class sessions.

In the PADI Open Water Diver course, you learn to use basic scuba gear including a dive computer and standard accessories. The equipment you wear will be chosen by an Aggieland Scuba Representative to ensure your comfort throughout the course.

Your instructor will contact you the week before the class starts to set up a time to fit you for the equipment used in the class and to get the required reading material.
