4. THIS SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED WITH THE BENEFIT OF A COMMITMENT FOR TITLE INSURANCE ISSUED BY UNIVERSITY TITLE COMPANY, GF #00050780, EFFECTIVE DATE: FEBRUARY 23, 2005, TO WIT THE FOLLOWING COMMENTS RELATED TO SCHEDULE "B" OF SAID COMMITMENT:

OF THE TEN EASEMENTS THAT ARE LISTED ON THE COMMITMENT, THE FOLLOWING TWO EASEMENTS ARE APPLICABLE TO ST. ELMO SUBDIVISION, PHASE TWO:

a.) VARIABLE WIDTH CITY OF BRYAN ELECTRICAL EASEMENT, VOL. 2318, PG. 159, DOES NOT MATHEMATICALLY CLOSE AND HAS AN AMBIGUOUS LOCATION. THE OWNER IS THIS EASEMENT WHICH LIES WITHIN THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION. BY VIRTUE OF FILING THIS PLAT, A 20' PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT (WITH ATTACHED GUY EASEMENT) IS THIS PLAT TO CREATE A 20' PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT CENTERED ON THE EXISTING ELECTRIC LINE AND FOR THIS PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT TO SUPERSEDE AND REPLACE THE 20' PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT RECORDED IN VOL. 2318, PG. 159

b.) 50' WIDE DeSOTO PIPELINE COMPANY EASEMENT, VOL. 2887, PG. 175. THIS EASEMENT IS CREATED AS "15" ON ONE SIDE AND 35" ON OTHER SIDE OF THE CENTERLINE DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT...." THIS SURVEY HAS ASSUMED THE 15' WIDTH LIES ON THE ROAD SIDE OF THE DESCRIBED LINE. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT LEGAL COUNSEL BE SOUGHT AS TO CURATIVE ACTION WHICH CAN BE TAKEN TO RESOLVE THE AMBIGUITY AS TO HOW TO POSITION THE 15' AND 35' WIDTHS WITH RESPECT TO THE DESCRIBED CENTERLINE.

5. POTABLE WATER WILL BE PROVIDED BY WICKSON WATER SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT.

6. NOTES FROM THE BRAZOS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

a.) NO ON SITE SEWAGE FACILITY (OSSF) AUTHORIZATION TO CONSTRUCT FOR AN INDIMIDUAL LOT WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT FIRST HAVING A SITE EVALUATION REPORT ON FILE FOR THAT INDIMIDUAL LOT. THE SITE EVALUATION MUST BE DONE BY A STATE LICENSED SITE EVALUATOR. b.) ALL LOTS SERVED BY AN OSSF MUST COMPLY WITH COUNTY AND STATE

REGULATIONS. NO OSSF MAY BE INSTALLED ON ANY LOT WITHOUT THE ISSUANCE OF AN "AUTHORIZATION TO CONSTRUCT" ISSUED BY THE BRAZOS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PRIVATE SEWAGE FACILITY
REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF BRAZOS COUNTY,
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 21.084 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE. NO OSSF DRAIN FIELD IS TO ENCROACH ON THE 100-FOOT SANITARY ZONE O PRIVATE WATER WELLS OR 150 FEET OF PUBLIC WATER WELLS. A SANITARY ZONE MUST BE CLEARLY DELINEATED AROUND ALL EXISTING PUBLIC OR PRIVATE WELLS ON THE SUBDIVISION PLAT OR WITHIN 150 FEET OF THE SUBDIVISION BOUNDARY.
