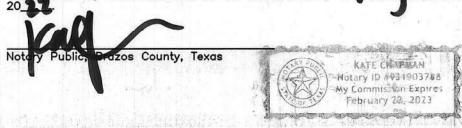

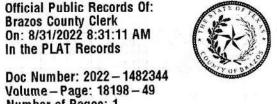

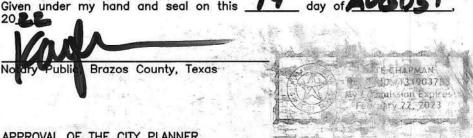

- 3) N 71°59'48" E for a distance of 30.00 feet to a found 1/2-inch iron rod marking an exterior ell corner of this tract, said iron rod also marking the northwest corner of Lot 14, Block 2, THE TRADITIONS SUBDIVISION, PHASE 26 according to the Final Plat recorded in Volume 12630, Page 25 (O.R.B.C.);

THENCE: along the common line of this tract, said Lot 14, Block 2 and Lots 13 and 12, Block 2 of said THE TRADITIONS SUBDIVISION, PHASE 26 (12630/25) for the following three (3) calls:

- 4) N 71°59'48" E for a distance of 157.01 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 1.1278 acres of land
