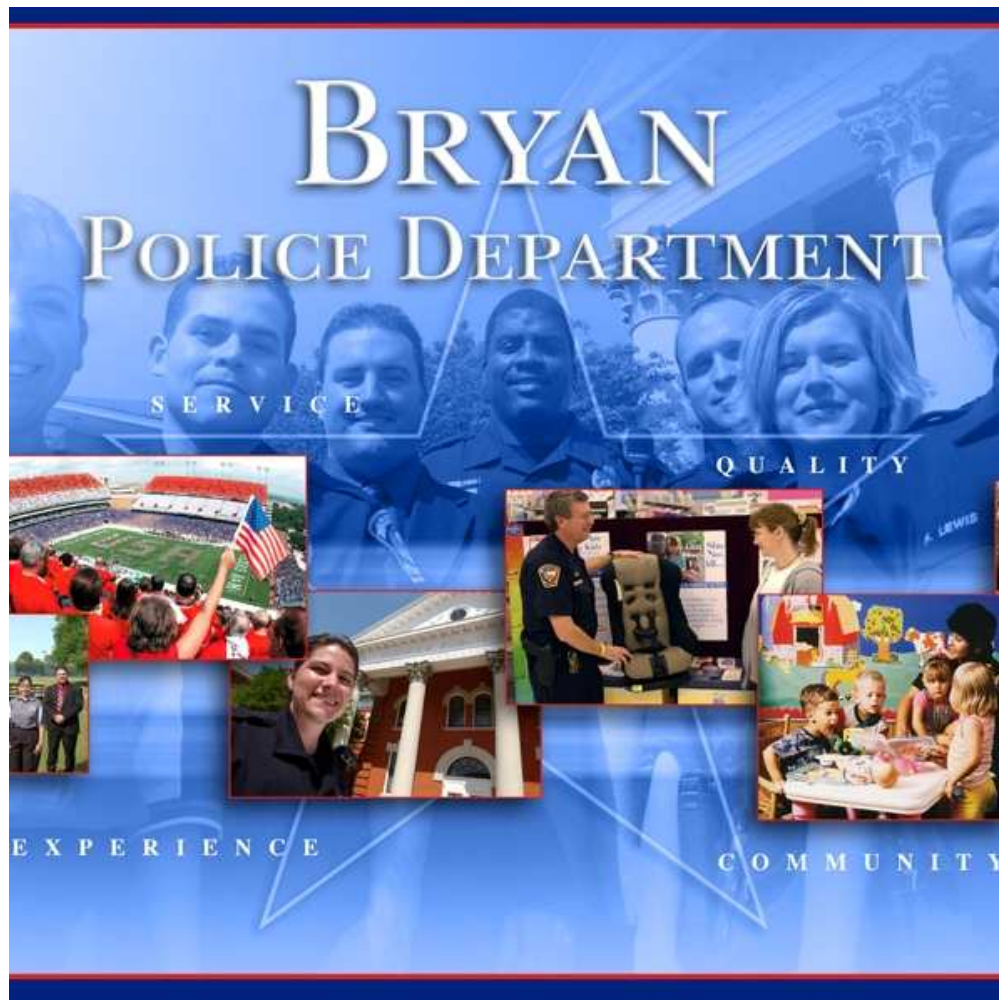

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INTRODUCTION

In accordance with the Professional Standards Division Standard Operating Procedures 212.0, this report has been generated for the administration and personnel assigned to the Professional Standards Division of the Bryan Police Department. The figures were generated from the Professional Standards Database.

The information found in this database and stated in this report is statistical in nature. The purpose of the database is to find trends in officer activity that can be analyzed by the administration. All of the information contained in this report should be looked at objectively by those with the experience and knowledge necessary to make an educated analysis.

The material in this report was compiled from Bryan Police Department records from January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006. All police officers employed during the time period are included in this report regardless of their employment status at the time of printing.

METHODS OF CALCULATION

The Professional Standards Database is capable of generating many reports for each of the types of data collected. In most of the reports and tables, the calculations should be obvious based on the information collected. In others, the data may appear to be “inaccurate” because the numbers will not add up to the totals. This is especially apparent in the Use of Force tables. The reason for this is the differences in the methods of calculation.

For example, Use of Force statistics can be calculated in three ways. A “tally” of the uses of force can be calculated:

1. **By record number.** The number of different incidents, or record numbers, for an officer can be counted.

2. **By involved subjects.** The numbers of people that have been involved in a Use of Force with that officer are counted.

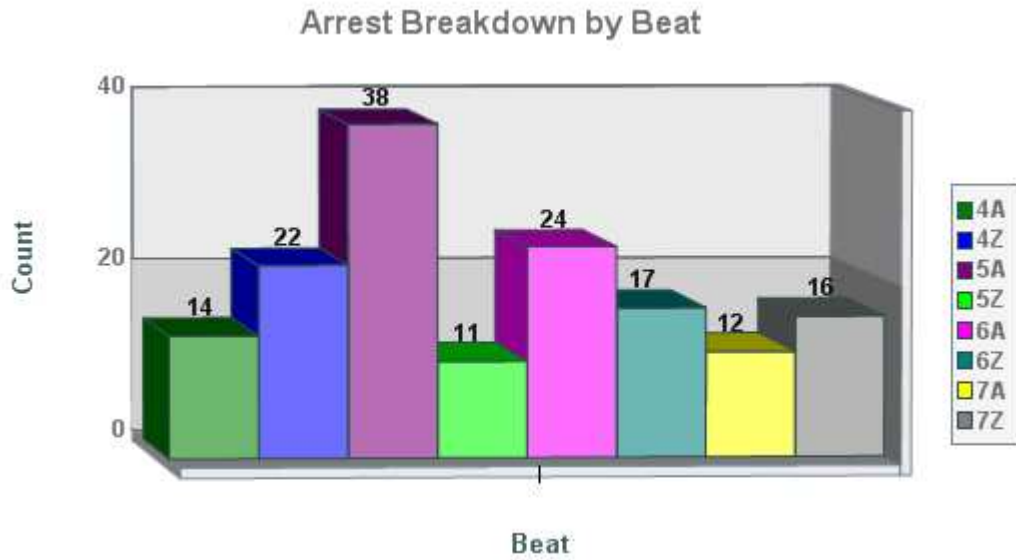

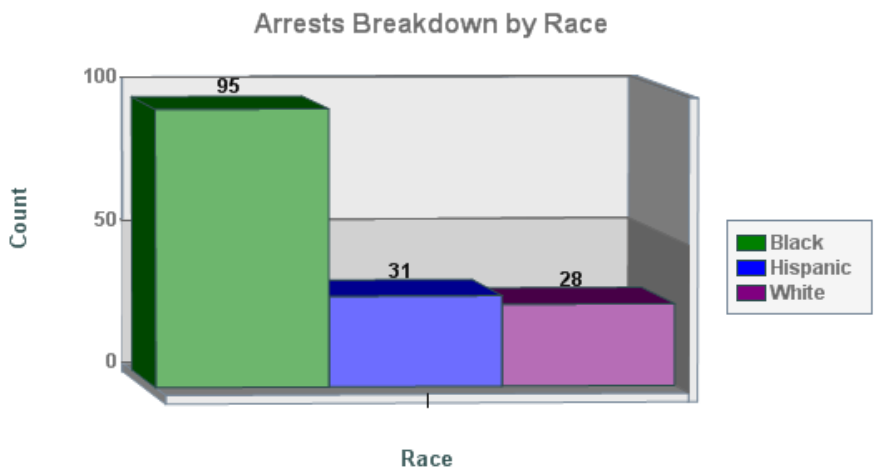

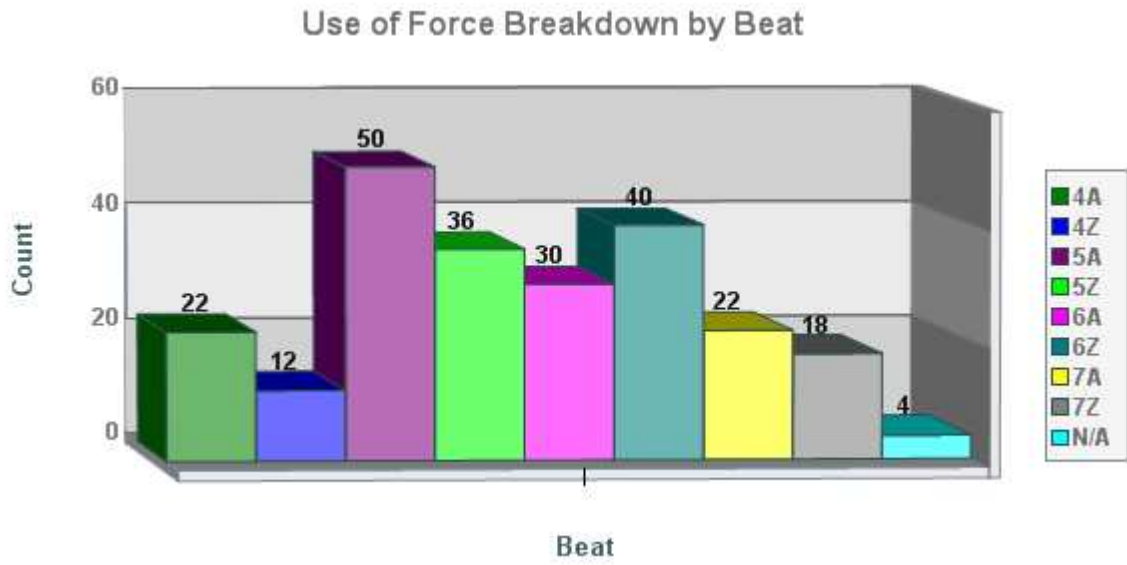

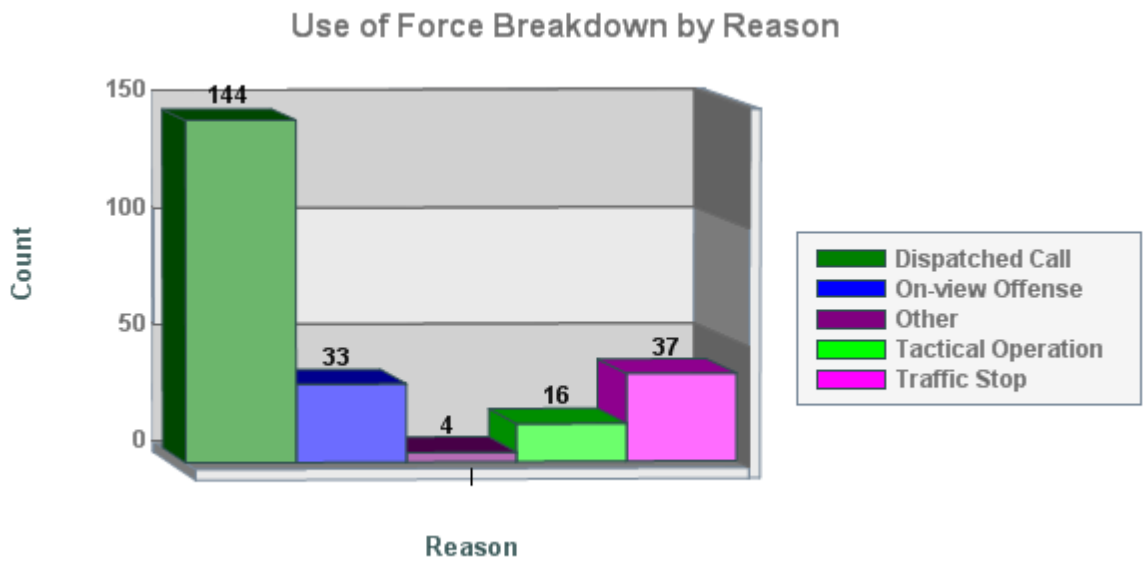

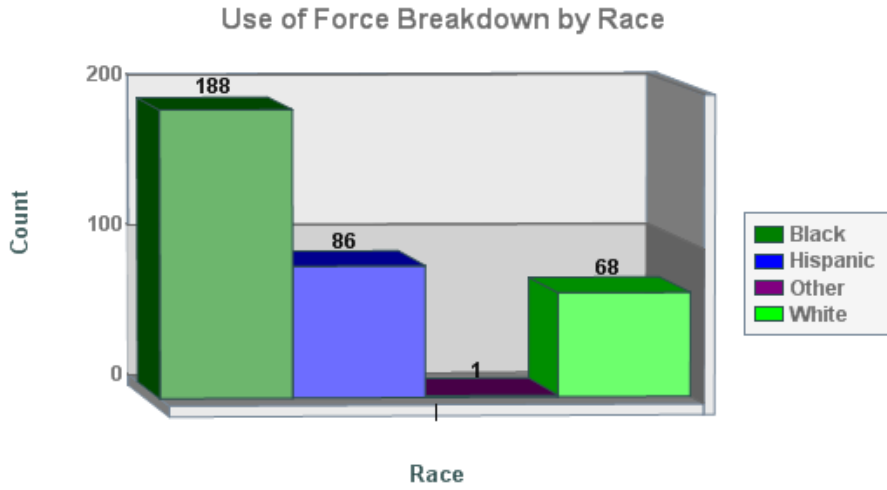

Use of Force Breakdown by Type

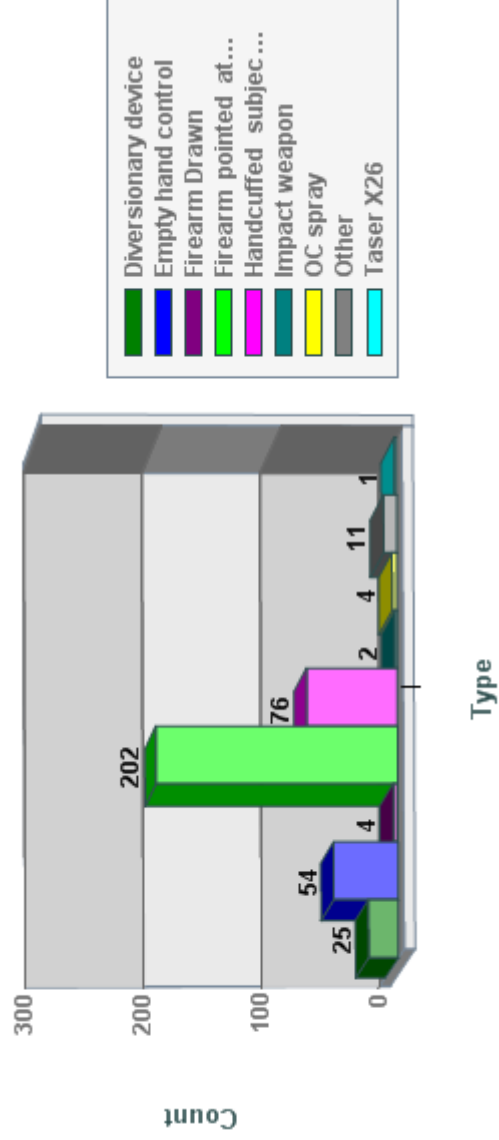

USE OF FORCE ANALYSIS 2006

The Professional Standards Division undertook an analysis of the Use of Force in the year of 2006. There were 156 Use of Force reports filed in the year of 2006. 343 actors were involved in these reports with 379 different types of force applied. The Use of Force reports were studied in reference to the geographic beat where they occurred, the race and sex of the offender, the type of force applied and the shift of all involved officers.

Geographic Beats: From 2005 to 2006 there was a 36 % decrease in the incidents of force applied to offenders. The most significant decreases were in beat 4Z and 5Z. 4Z went from 34 incidents in 2005 to 12 in 2006 and 5Z went from 54 incidents in 2005 to 36 in 2006.

Sex and Sex of Offender: The number of offenders that force was applied to decreased 38% from 2005 to 2006. This decrease was proportionate to both sexes and the three major races represented in the City of Bryan.

Type of Force Employed: Force employed on offenders decreased by 24% from 2005 to 2006. This is the first year that diversionary devices were used so the number of incidents showed a major increase. Empty hand control on the other hand decreased from 102 incidents to 54.

Policy Compliance: Seven (2%) of the 379 forces employed were to be found non compliant by the Chain of Command. This is a significant increase from 2005's .4%.

Shift of Officers Involved: Following current trends Night Patrol still has the most significant incidents of Force being used. Power shift showed an increase from 19 to 27, DDT went from 14 to 9.

Vehicular Pursuit Analysis 2006

Bryan police officers initiated vehicular pursuit fourteen times in 2006, a significant increase from the six initiated in 2005. Pursuits were studied in reference to geographic beat where the pursuit was initiated, day of week, traffic conditions, road conditions, length in minutes, reason for initiation of pursuit, capture of defendant, resulting injury, resulting property damage, policy compliance, and disciplinary action to officers. Additionally, pursuing officers were studied as to shift assignment and experience level. Corresponding graphs are included at the end of each section.

*Note 06-VP012 was stopped then restarted thus it has two primary officers. This will result in the graphs showing 15 pursuits instead of 14.

Geographic Beat: It is interesting to note that in 2005 beat 5A had no (0%) vehicle pursuits and in 2006 they had the most, 5 (36%), pursuits. 6Z had four pursuits (29%), 4A had three (21%), 4A had two (14%), and 5Z had one (7%). Beats 6A, 7A, and 7Z all had zero pursuits in 2006.

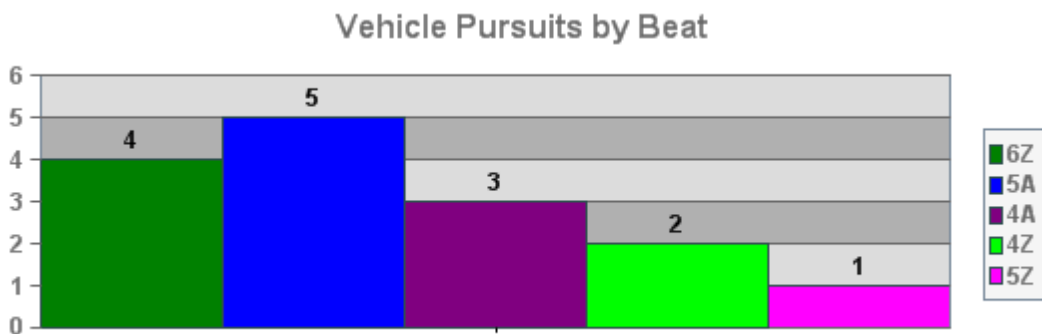

Day of the Week: There seems to be no pattern distinguished between the day of week and the number of pursuits initiated. There were ten pursuits initiated during the week and only five initiated on the weekend. Wednesday had the most occurrences with five pursuits (36%), followed by Thursday with four (29%). Two pursuits were initiated both on Friday and Saturday (14%) and both Sunday and Monday had one each (7%).

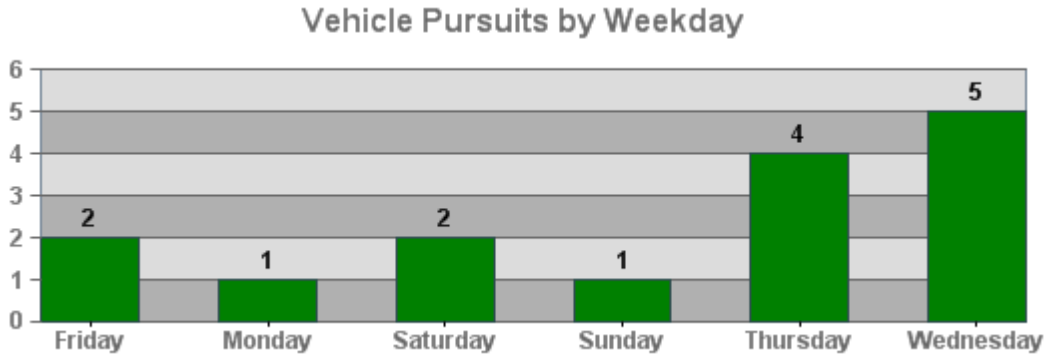

Traffic Conditions: The traffic conditions were reported as: *none to minor* -twelve (87%) and *moderate* -two (13%).

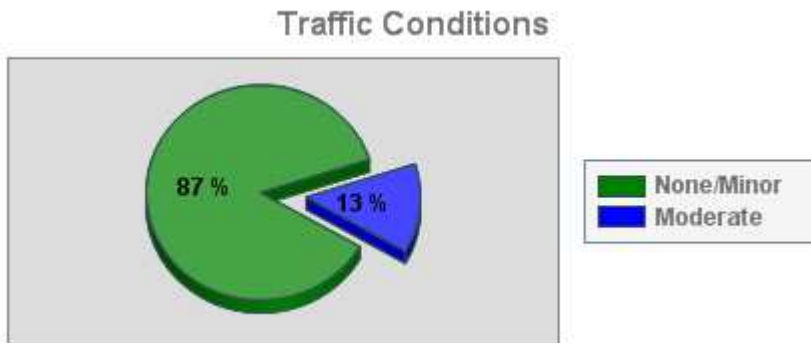

Road Conditions: Most of the pursuits took place on dry roads. 93% (13) pursuits were on dry roads with only one (7%) happening in wet conditions.

Length in minutes: Two of the pursuits were clocked at one (1) minute each. The longest pursuit was forty-eight (48) minutes in length. The average time elapsed was calculated at approximately eight (8) minutes. The length of 06-VP014 severely skews the average length of pursuits; excluding this event the average length is five (5) minutes.

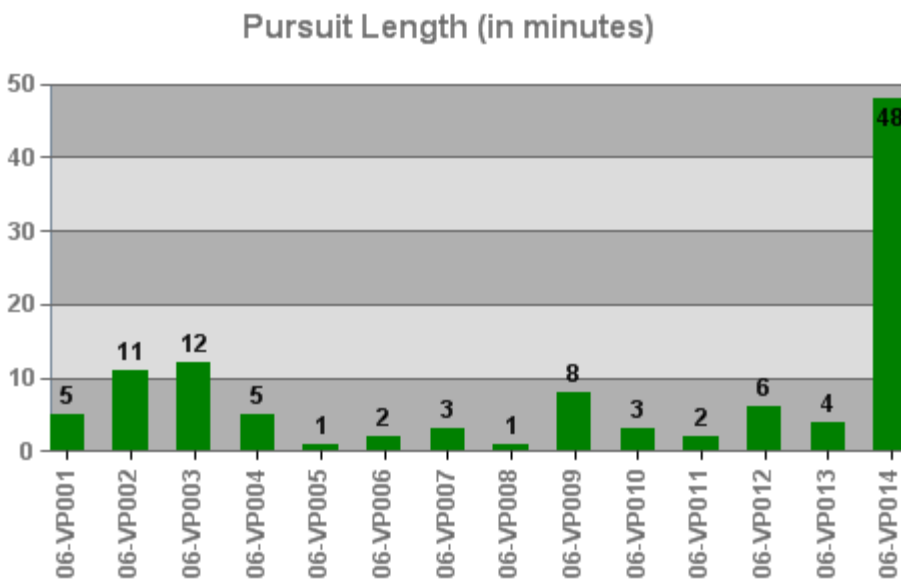

Reason for initiation: These pursuits were all initiated for various reasons ranging from suspicious person to aggravated sexual assault of a child. There were two aggravated assaults suspects and three DWIs. All three of the DWIs resulted in DWI charges being filed.

Results: Of the fourteen pursuits, twelve offenders were apprehended, one offender was apprehended and later charged and two offenders were not apprehended. In all the pursuits where the offender was apprehended charges were filed. Evading charges were filed on all offenders. Four of the pursuits resulted in property damage, two resulted in suspect vehicle damage, two damaged legally parked cars, one damaged personal property and one offender knocked down a stop sign.
