#### **INTRODUCTION**

In accordance with the Professional Standards Division Standard Operating Procedures 212.0, this report has been generated for the administration and personnel assigned to the Professional Standards Division of the Bryan Police Department. The figures were generated from the Professional Standards Database.

The information found in this database and stated in this report is statistical in nature. The purpose of the database is to find trends in officer activity that can be analyzed by the administration. All of the information contained in this report should be looked at objectively by those with the experience and knowledge necessary to make an educated analysis.

The material in this report was compiled from Bryan Police Department records from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008. All police officers employed during this time period are included in this report regardless of their employment status at the time of printing.

#### METHODS OF CALCULATION

The Professional Standards Database is capable of generating many reports for each of the types of data collected. In most of the reports and tables, the calculations should be obvious based on the information collected. In others, the data may appear to be "inaccurate" because the numbers will not add up to the totals. This is especially apparent in the Use of Force tables. The reason for this is the differences in the methods of calculation.

For example, Use of Force statistics can be calculated in three ways. A "tally" of the uses of force can be calculated"

**1. By record number.** The number of different incidents, or record numbers, for for an officer can be counted.

#### Arrest Breakdown by Beat



#### Arrest Breakdown by Beat



### Arrests Breakdown by Race



### Arrests Breakdown by Race



### Arrests Breakdown by Sex






Arrest Breakdown by Action




### Use of Force Breakdown by Beat



## Use of Force Breakdown by Beat




Use of Force Breakdown by Reason



Use of Force Breakdown by Reason





Use of Force Breakdown by Race



## Use of Force Breakdown by Sex






Use of Force Breakdown by Type



## Use of Force Breakdown by Type



#### **USE OF FORCE ANALYSIS 2008**

The Professional Standards Division reviewed the Use of Force Reports for the year of 2008 in comparison to 2007. There were 147 Use of Force reports filed in the year of 2008, the same number of reports were filed in 2007. 327 individuals were involved in these reports with 379 different types of force applied, an increase in both categories from 2007 (284 individuals in 2007, 15.1% increase, and 295 types of force, 28.5% increase). The Use of Force reports were studied in reference to the geographic beat where they occurred, the race and sex of the offender, the types of force employed, the reason for contact and the shift assignment of involved officers.

Geographic Beat: From 2007 to 2008 there was a 2.1% decrease in the total incidents of force applied to offenders in terms of geographic beat. There was also a decrease in the number of officers affecting force, from 74 officers in 2007 to 57 officers in 2008, a decrease of 22.97% (including TRT). Beat 5Z showed the largest increase in use of force incidents, from 28 in 2007 to 41 in 2008, an increase of 46.4%. There were also increases of use of force incidents in the following beats: 4A, from 12 incidents in 2007 to 14 incidents in 2008, an increase of 16.7%; 6A, from 22 incidents in 2007 to 27 incidents in 2008, an increase of 22.7%; and 6Z, from 33 incidents in 2007 to 37 incidents in 2008, an increase of 12.1%. The largest decrease for 2008 was actually in the category of 'N/A,' which represents use of force incidents outside the city limits of the City of Bryan. There was a decrease of 75%, from 4 incidents in 2007 to 1 incident in 2008, in that category. For the geographic beats inside the City of Bryan, beat 4Z showed the largest decrease in use of force incidents, from 21 incidents in 2007 to 10 in 2008, a decrease of 52.4%. There were also decreases of use of force incidents in the following beats: 5A, from 43 incidents in 2007 to 35 incidents in 2008, a decrease of 18.6%, and 7A, from 17 incidents in 2007 to 11 incidents in 2008, a 35.3% decrease. Beat 7Z showed no change between 2007 and 2008, staying constant at 14 incidents.

**Reason for Contact:** Total Use of Force reports related to dispatched calls for service decreased again from 112 in 2007 to 105 in 2008, a decrease of 15.3%. This continues a trend of decrease from 2006 with 144 incidents. Total Use of Force reports related to On-View Offenses decreased from 41 incidents in 2007 to 40 incidents in 2008, a decrease of 2.4%. Use of Force incidents related to traffic stops increased from 30 incidents in 2007 to 32 incidents in 2008, an increase of 6.7%. The biggest increase in reason for contact was found for Tactical Operations, from 13 in 2007 to 25 in 2008. However, this corresponds with the large drop in the 'Other' category, from 11 in 2007 to 3 in 2008 (72.7% decrease) as a result of increased attention being paid to reporting procedures by PSD.

Race and Sex of the Subject: The overall number of subjects that force was applied to increased by 15.1% from 2007 to 2008 (284 subjects to 327). When comparing the race and sex of subjects, between 2007 and 2008, there were only two categories that saw decreases in incidents of force applied to them, those categories were black males and white males. Black males showed a small decrease from 139 incidents in 2007 to 137 in 2008. This decrease of 1.4% continues a decrease beginning in 2006 when there were 163 black males with force applied to them. White males also continued a pattern of small decreases, dropping from 56 subjects in 2007 to 53 in 2008, a 5.4% decrease. Hispanic males showed the smallest increase in uses of force applied to them, going from 43 subjects in 2007 to 55 in 2008, a still substantial 27.9% increase. The number of uses of force applied to females jumped dramatically in terms of percentage across all three races. This increase in the number of female subjects can be explained by the increase in Tactical Response Team use of force, as 30.5% (25) of the female subjects involved in use of force incidents in 2008 were subjects in Tactical Response Team operations. Black females increased from 27 in 2007 to 46 in 2008, an increase of 70.4%, white females increased from 9 in 2007 to 17 in 2008, an increase of 88.9%, and Hispanic females showed the

biggest increase, from 6 in 2007 to 19 in 2008, an increase of 216.7%. However, 17 of those 19 Hispanic female subjects in 2008 were subjects in Tactical Response Team operations, again, due to the increased use of TRT by the Brazos County Special Investigations Unit and the Bryan Police Department. In terms of the number of subjects, black subjects still have force applied to them most with a total of 183, an increase of 10.2% from 2007's 166 subjects. Hispanic and white subjects are close to the same although Hispanics showed the greatest increase, from 49 total in 2007 to 74 in 2008, a 51% increase. The total number of white subjects that force was applied to in 2008 was 70, an increase from 65 in 2007 by 7.7%.

**Type of Force Employed:** There was a large increase of the overall numbers of types of force employed on subjects, from 295 in 2007 to 379 in 2008, an increase of 28.5%. The type of force with the largest increase in use in the year 2008 was diversionary devices, used by TRT, which went from 16 uses in 2007 to 47 uses in 2008, a percentage increase of 193.75%. There were several types of force that showed a 100% increase or decrease, meaning those types doubled. However, those include items such as the use of an impact weapon that increased from 1 use in 2007 to 2 uses in 2008, ERI Weapon/Pepperball that increased from 0 in 2007 to 1 in 2008, and firearm discharged which decreased from 2 in 2007 to 0 in 2008. Officers' use of handcuffing a subject without arrest increased in 2008, going from 94 uses in 2007 to 104 in 2008, a 10.6% increase, while the use of empty hand control decreased 7.1% from 42 uses in 2007 to 39 uses in 2008. The use of OC spray also decreased substantially in 2008 by 44.4%, from 18 uses in 2007 to 10 uses in 2008. The total use of the Taser X26 decreased in 2008, dropping from 26 uses in 2007 to 22 in 2008, a 15.4% decrease. Out of those uses, 20 were policy compliant and 2 were found to be non-policy compliant. This equates to a 100% increase in non-policy complaint Taser usages (from 1 NPC use in 2007 to 2 in 2008) and a 20% decrease in policy compliant Taser usages (from 25 PC uses in 2007 to 20 in 2008). The total use of 'Firearm Pointed at Subject' increased by 62.1%, from 95 uses in 2007 to 154 uses in 2008. However, as seen on the following chart, 68 of those 154 uses were Tactical Response Team uses. Out of those 154 uses in 2008, only one was found to be non-policy compliant where all uses in 2007 were found to be policy compliant. This equates to a 100% increase (from 0 in 2007 to 1 in 2008) in non-policy complaint use and a 61.1% increase in policy compliant use.

**Policy Compliance:** In 2008, 3 uses of force were found to be non-policy compliant, a 200% increase from the 1 use that was non-policy compliant in 2007. Those three uses of force are equal to 0.79% of the total uses of force by the Bryan Police Department in 2008. This means that 99.21% of the types of force used by the Bryan Police Department in 2008 were found to be policy compliant.

Shift of Officers Involved: Night Patrol had the highest number of use of force incidents reported with a total of 81, an increase of 20.9% from 67 incidents in 2007. Night Team One actually decreased by 1, from 36 incidents in 2007 to 35 in 2008, and Night Team Two increased by 45.2%, from 31 uses of force in 2007 to 45 in 2008. Day Patrol had a total of 58 use of force incidents in 2008, an increase of 3.6% from 56 incidents in 2007. Day Team One decreased by 1 incident, from 31 in 2007 to 30 in 2008, or 3.2%. Day Team Two increased by 3 incidents, from 25 in 2007 to 28 in 2008, or a 12% increase. Power Shift's use of force decreased a total of -75%, from 16 incidents in 2007 to 4 in 2008. DDT officers reported a decrease in uses of force from 13 in 2007 to 7 in 2008, a decrease of 46.2%. School Resource Officers showed no change in total number of uses of force, staying constant at 11 for 2007 and 2008. The Traffic Safety Unit decreased by 1 incident, from 4 in 2007 to 3 in 2008.

Race and Sex of Officers Involved: Of the 56 individual officers (not including TRT) who applied force to subjects during 2008, 39 of those officers were white males, a percentage of 69.6%. The second highest category of officers who enacted force was Hispanic males with 7

officers of 12.5%. Black male officers and white female officers both had 4 uses of force incidents, each at 7.1%. There were also uses of force by 1 Hispanic female officer and 1 Asian male officer, each at 1.8%.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

Although the number of Use of Force reports filed stayed constant from 2007 to 2008 at 147, there was a very large increase in the amount of force (i.e. types of force used) and the number of subjects force was used upon (see race and sex of subject). This can mostly be attributed to the Tactical Response Team (TRT) and their increased use by the Bryan Police Department as well as the Brazos County Special Investigations Unit. By comparison, TRT filed 12 use of force reports in 2007 and in 2008 TRT filed 25 use of force reports, an increase of 108%. In those 25 reports in 2008, 72 subjects had force affected on them, compared to 35 subjects in the 12 TRT use of force reports in 2007, an increase of 105.7%. There are three areas in the following chart that demonstrate the large increase in TRT use of force, those are firearm pointed at subject, diversionary device and handcuffed subject without arrest. In order to obtain a more useful analysis of department-wide individual use of force, the following chart removes all the TRT numbers from both the 2007 and 2008 Use of Force Reports. The chart on the next page shows 2007 and 2008 Use of Force by Type and Reason for Contact.

As you can see in the chart above, by filtering out the Tactical Response Team numbers for both 2007 and 2008 we see that the increase in use of force for 2008 was not as large as one might assume from a first glance. Of the 147 use of force reports filed in 2008, 25 of those were filed by the Tactical Response Team. Out of the 379 individual types of force used against subjects in 2008, 139 of those were affected by the Tactical Response Team. This makes the number of individual types of force used by individual officers drop to 240, an increase of only 2 incidents from 2007 or 0.84%. This also represents a continual decline in the overall number of use of force incidents by officers from the past few years, dropping from 467 in 2005 to 298 in 2006, 238 in 2007 and now 240 in 2008.

In the individual type of force categories, there are several changes to note. The first thing to note is the category of handcuffed subject without arrest. The Tactical Response Team logged 22

uses of this type of force making a total of 104 uses for the whole department in 2008, a 10.6% increase. However, by removing the Tactical Response Team numbers you see a decrease in the use of handcuffing subjects without arrest, from 92 in 2007 to 82 in 2008, or 10.9%. The second category to notice is the category of firearm pointed at subject. The overall department numbers, including the Tactical Response Team, showed an increase of 59 uses, from 95 in 2007 to 154 in 2008, a 62.1% increase. The Tactical Response Team accounted for 68 of those 154 uses. That increase from 35 uses in 2007 to 68 uses in 2008 equates to an increase of 94.3%. However, even with removing the Tactical Response Team numbers, there was still an increase in use of force of 43.3% by individual officers to 86 uses in 2008, increasing from 60 uses in 2007.

The large increase in Tactical Response Team use of force numbers can likely be attributed to the increased use of the Tactical Response Team by both the Bryan Police Department and a large increase in use by the Brazos County Special Investigation Unit to conduct search warrants around the city.

As discussed earlier, the use of both OC spray and the Taser X26 declined in 2008. In regards to Taser usage, currently there is no mechanism to account for an officer presenting or threatening the use of a Taser and its affect on a subject's willingness to avoid behavior necessitating an officer's use of force.

The following recommendations are based on this analysis of the 2007 and 2008 Use of Force Reports:

- **Equipment:** None
- **Training:** Continue annual Taser training as it is having an effect on the type and amount of force applied to suspects. Also continue firearms training for the low ready position as opposed to the on target position which would appear to have an effect on the drop in use of force by 'firearm pointed at subject.'
- **Policy:** Consider capturing data related to "Taser equipped" and "Taser Warned" to enable a more accurate analysis of the effectiveness of the presence of the Taser in reducing the need for use of force.

#### Vehicular Pursuit Analysis 2008

The Bryan Police Department initiated vehicular pursuits seven (7) times in 2008, a decrease from ten (10) pursuits in 2007. Pursuits were studied in reference to geographic beat where the pursuit was initiated, day of week, traffic conditions, road conditions, length in minutes, reason for initiation of pursuit, capture of defendant, resulting injury, resulting property damage, policy compliance, and disciplinary action to officers. Additionally, pursuing officers were studied as to shift assignment and experience level. Corresponding charts are included at the end of each section.

**Geographic Beat:** The beat with the highest number of pursuits in 2008 and 2007 was beat 5Z, with 3 pursuits in 2008 and 4 in 2007. The 2008 number of 3 pursuits makes up 43% of the total of 7 pursuits in 2008. Beat 5A had the second most pursuits reported in 2008 with 2 or 28.6% of the total. This was a drop of one pursuit for beat 5A from 2007. Beats 4A and 6A both had one pursuit in 2008 (14.3%), two beats that had no pursuits in them in 2007. Also, beats 7Z and 4Z had 1 pursuit and 2 pursuits last year, respectively, and neither had pursuits in them in 2008.



**Day of the Week:** Last year, 2007, 70% of the pursuits initiated by Bryan Police Officers occurred on the weekend (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and 30% on weekdays. In 2008, three (3) pursuits occurred on the weekend, all 3 on Saturday, making up 42.9% of all pursuits. 3 pursuits also occurred on Mondays, also making up 42.9% and there was 1 pursuit reported on a Thursday, making up 14.3%.



**Traffic Conditions:** 4 of the 7 reported pursuits in 2008 reported traffic conditions of *none/minor*, making up 57% of the pursuits. In 2007, there were 11 reported traffic conditions for 10 pursuits, 9 of those (82%) were reported as none/minor. The other 3 pursuits of 2008 reported traffic conditions of *moderate*, making up 43% of the total number of pursuits. In 2007 only 1 pursuit (9%) listed traffic conditions as moderate.






**Road Conditions:** All 7 (100%) of the reported vehicular pursuits during the year 2008 occurred under dry road conditions.





**Length in Minutes:** The average length in minutes for pursuits in the year 2008 was 4.71 minutes. The longest pursuit clocked in at 13 minutes in length. This one longer pursuit somewhat skews the average since each of the other 6 pursuits were clocked at 5 minutes or under. Taking out the longest pursuit, 08-VP003, the average for the remaining 6 pursuits was 3.33 minutes.

**Pursuits Compared to Policy:** Of the 7 pursuits enacted in the year 2008, 3 pursuits, 43%, were found to be in violation of Bryan PD pursuit policy. There were a total of 4 officers involved in those 3 pursuits found to be non-policy compliant. The other 4 pursuits, 57%, were found to be policy compliant and there were a total of 5 officers involved in those 4 pursuits.

**Pursuits by Officer's Shift Assignments:** Day Team 2 had the highest number of pursuits enacted by officers in 2008 with 4 pursuits or 44.4% of the 9 total officers. Night Team 2 had the second largest number of officers who enacted pursuits with 2 officers or 22.2% of the 9 total officers. This was a drop for Night Team 2 from 2007 where there were 5 Night Team 2 officers who enacted pursuits. Night Team 1, Day Team 2 and Power shift all enacted 1 pursuit each, each accounting for 11.1% of the 9 total officers. Officers from DDT and the Traffic Safety Unit each enacted 1 pursuit in 2007 but logged no pursuits in 2008.



**Reason for Initiation:** The seven pursuits in 2008 were initiated for various reasons ranging from a possible robbery suspect to subjects that were believed to have abducted another person. There were two pursuits initiated because of a possible DWI driver (one without headlights on and one driver traveling northbound in the southbound lane). The three pursuits that were found to be non-policy compliant were initiated for warrant service, a suspect involved in a hit and run earlier in the day, and because of a seatbelt violation and disregarding a stop sign.

**Results:** There were a total of 12 subjects involved in the 7 pursuits in 2008. Out of those, 3 subjects were not charged with any violations and the other 9 suspects were all apprehended, one after a standoff with police, and charges were filed for each of those 9 suspects. There were 7 charges of evading arrest/detention, 2 charges of DWI, 2 charges of DWLI Enhanced, 3 charges of Manufacture/Delivery PG2 1<4g, 1 charge of Tampering with evidence, 2 charges of Failure to stop and leave information, 2 charges of FMFR, 2 charges of Disregarding a stop sign, 1 charge for a safety belt violation, 1 charge of unlawful restraint, and 1 suspect with 4 municipal warrants. There were no personal injuries reported in the 7 pursuits in 2008 and only 1 pursuit resulted in property damage which was to a barbed wire fence and a street sign. In all 7 of the pursuits officers used emergency lights and in 6 of the pursuits officers also used sirens. It is also interesting to note that only two pursuits occurred in the first 6 months of the year, one in April and one in June. The other 5 pursuits occurred in the second half of the year (July-December).
