City of Bryan Mobile Food Vendor FAQ's

How Long is the Permit Valid?

Permits are valid for one (1) year and expire on December 31

What is the Permit Fee?

Mobile Food Trucks and Concession Trailers;

- New \$500/year/vending unit
- o Renewal \$250/year/vending unit

Concession Carts;

- New \$250/year/vending unit for the
- Renewal \$125/year/vending unit

How are Inspections Performed?

 Vending units are inspected annually at the time of permit issuance. An appointment must be scheduled for each inspection; walk-ins are not accepted. Inspections can be scheduled by calling the Public Works Call Center at 209-5900.

Where Can I Sell?

- On private property with written permission from the owner
- · Within one hundred feet to a property with an active building permit
- Public park facility when park concessions are not open

Do I Need Written Permission to be on Private Property?

• Yes. A copy of the written permission to operate in a specific location, signed by the private property owner, shall be kept within the mobile vending unit at all times.

How Long Can I Stay Stationary at One Location?

- No more than five (5) consecutive days
- Not to exceed eight(8) hours/location/day
- Not to exceed thirty (30) minutes on any public street designated on the City of Bryan's Thoroughfare Plan as major collector or lesser
- Vending unit must be removed from the point of sale each day and may not remain parked overnight

Where Can I Not Conduct Sales?

- In congested areas where the operation impedes vehicular or pedestrian traffic or where it impedes access to the entrance of any adjacent building or driveway
- In public parking spaces in downtown Bryan and designated bike lane
- Within the boundaries of Downtown First Fridays unless specifically authorized by permit issued by the Downtown Bryan Association

How Can I Dispose of My Waste?

- 1) Form a partnership with a food service establishment for disposal of solid waste and wastewater;
- 2) Dispose of solid waste in your residential container as long as it does not overfill your container; or
- 3) Dispose of wastewater at the City of Bryan, Still Creek WWTP located at 2028 Quality Park Lane, Bryan, TX 77803

What are My Responsibilities Around the Point of Sale?

- Clean-up, contain and remove all waste from the point of sale
- Vending unit must be self-sufficient for water and sewer (e.g. no direct connections to water and sewer are allowed). Extension cords are allowed as long as they do not pose a threat of fire or personal injury and permission for use is granted by the property owner
- Signage may not be placed in the right of way
- · Display current vending authorization sticker on permitted vending unit
